Each album prompt will include some ideas to help you put your pages together, but they also purposely leave a lot up to your imagination. That way, your personal style will shine through and the resulting book will be very much your own.

For the last Scrap your Day of 2008, let your photos create your design. Decide how many you want to include, then print them at a size that will let you include everything you want.

You can print your photos at home in a custom size or use a photo editing program to paste the images into one large image, scale the pictures all to the size you want, then save the image and print it at full sheet size. If you order prints rather than printing at home, that can be useful as you can then order one or two 8x10 prints and cut them into the dozens of photos you want to include.

Likewise, if you were too busy enjoying the day to take many photos, you can print them at a larger size than normal to fill the page with just a photo or two or three.

As you clear away the Christmas evidence, you might want to snag a little something here or there to include in your page, like a gift tag, a greeting card or a scrap of your favourite wrapping paper.
