Getting started...

Thank you so much for joining us for this online album workshop -- the first of its kind at Two Peas! Over the next six weeks, we'll be putting together an album but there's plenty more as well: photo editing techniques to try, journeys to calculate and future travels to plan!

This album's framework has three sections: Here, There and Everywhere. In the first section - Here - we'll document the places near us and the short journeys we take regularly. The second section - There - will be home to the travels you have taken so far. Section three - Everywhere - will be filled with your notes and a few daydreams about the places you still want to go. We'll spend two weeks on each section of the book.

Throughout the project, you'll see four albums from start to finish, which means we'll be looking at the photographs themselves, several journaling techniques to help our albums make sense and the crafty techniques used to make the example pages. I encourage you to use the supplies you love and have available to work on this project -- there are no special supplies that are required. To give you an idea of what you will be seeing, the next four pages include a shopping list from each designer, with clickable links to the items they used. If you see something you really want to recreate, you can come back to this prompt to find pretty much anything you will need.

The prompts for this project will be delivered on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays -- eighteen prompts over six weeks. Which does mean that this doesn't count as one of those eighteen prompts. And it means that tomorrow is really when things start rolling! But there's plenty to read here to get ready, and the message board is open all day, every day, so come say hello whenever you fancy! I can't wait to learn more about you and the places that are close to your heart.

REFERENCE MATERIAL

I know technology can really throw us some confusion some times, but everything for *Here, There & Everywhere* should be simple as can be. Your first step is to bookmark one webpage - our class home at http://www.twopeasinabucket.com/education_class.asp?cl=11. From there, you'll be able to navigate to anything you might need: back-up copies of the class prompts, the digital files and photo-editing materials, the gallery for sharing your pages and the private discussion forum to chat with other participants. Everything in one central place, so no worries about getting lost!

Each prompt will come to you by email right to your inbox, so you don't have to log in to access the materials throughout the week. The larger files, like the digital kit and photo-editing materials will need to be downloaded from the website, as files that large don't tend to do well with email. When there is something new to download, I'll let you know in the prompt email so you won't miss anything. And in case you don't receive an email for some reason or you accidentally delete it, you'll also be able to access the prompts from our class page whenever you need them.

The [class discussion forum](#) is only available to class participants, and it's a great place to ask any questions and share ideas. Stop by now and say hello to everyone! Of course there is no obligation to chat at all, but I look forward to a few good conversations over the next six weeks -- with familiar faces and new friends alike.

On our class page, you'll also find a link to upload your pages to the gallery. Uploading to the gallery is an easy, step-by-step process so you can just follow the instructions as you go through and you'll be fine. When you get to the step that asks if your gallery item is part of a challenge or class, make sure to tick the box for *Here, There & Everywhere* so we can see it on our class page! I hope you'll take the time now and then to leave a comment for other class participants when they share their work in the gallery too.

If at any time over the next six weeks you need to get in touch with a specific question, please don't hesitate to [send me an email](#). Keep in mind that I'm in England, so my time zone may be very different from yours, but time zones aside, I try to reply as quickly as possible and if I can't answer your question myself, I will try my best to find someone who can.
